I am sure you will agree with me that the Ministry of Finance technicians have succeeded in having the Tax Convention initialled in 6 months. On the other hand, however, two years were needed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to arrive to a final conclusion on the translation details. Thus, I am pleased to know that the job is totally concluded.

I would like to inform you that the Brazilian Minister of Finance, Mr. Mário Henrique Simonsen, is visiting Salzburg on the 26/27 period of the next month of May, when he will be attending a Seminar on Foreign Capital Investment which will be held at that city. He would like to be able to sign the Brazil-Austria Tax Convention at that occasion in Wien, if at all possible.

Therefore, I would appreciate it if you could take the necessary steps on the Austrian side, in order to enable the signature to occur at the suggested date upon the stay of our Minister in your country.

The Brazilian Embassy in Wien has already contacted the Austrian Ministry of Finance regarding the subject.
